Grow Group 1:

"The Gospel of Luke"

Instructor: Pastor Rich Weitzel

<u>Location</u>: Classroom #104 (Office Annex)

<u>Class Overview</u>: Luke is the only non-Jewish author whose writings are included in the New Testament. His Gospel is filled with historical detail as he develops a record of the life of Jesus for his Gentile friend, Theophilus. Sometimes characterized as the most beautiful gospel writer, Luke emphasizes more than any other gospel the compassion and special interest Jesus had for the poor, for women, and all non-Jewish people--including representatives of the Roman government. Luke underscores that Jesus is the Savior for all people--especially those viewed with disdain and marginalized by traditional Jewish orthodoxy. We will study chapters 9-17 and Jesus' ministry in the regions around Galilee, in Judea and Perea.

"2 Corinthians"

<u>Class Overview</u>: Paul visited the church at Corinth after writing 1 Corinthians. Because of this painful visit, he wrote another letter to reconcile and challenge them. He challenged their generosity and willingness to endure suffering. We will dive into this letter to discover the history that took place as well as how we can make application to our own lives.
